

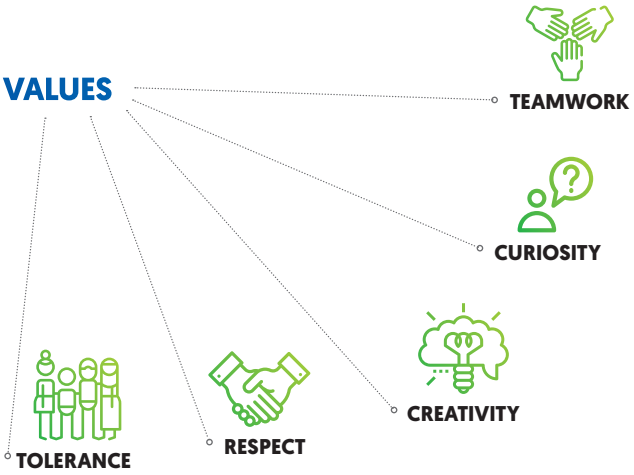

WELCOME TO THE EUROPEAN SCHOOL LJUBLJANA!

The European School Ljubljana is the only Slovenian school in a network of the accredited European schools. It will open its doors for the first time to the pupils of the first and second years of the primary school level on 1 September 2018.

The main aim of the European school in Ljubljana is to co-create a supportive and encouraging learning environment for education and schooling of children and teenagers from different linguistic and cultural environments. Together with pupils and parents we wish to build bridges between diversities, strengthen justice, encourage young pupils on their ways, identify potentials of each and every individual pupil, and at the same time achieve high educational standards. Using innovative pedagogical practices we will encourage curiosity, peer collaboration, respect and ethics, and commit ourselves to responsible European citizenship values.

WHY JOIN US?

We invite pupils, who:

- are willing to develop and educate themselves in a culturally and linguistically colourful environment.
- have a wish to deepen their foreign language knowledge and skills.
- wish to fully develop their potentials in an encouraging environment.

We:

- offer pupils a multicultural and multilingual environment with native speakers.
- educate in respecting diversity.
- implement a European school system programme with 60 years of tradition.
- carry out part of the programme in the first foreign language.
- appreciate a holistic development of pupils to fully develop their potentials in mathematics, science, languages, art, physical education, social sciences and other areas.
- carefully follow our pupils' progress, offer professional guidance and counselling on their career/university choices, and by enabling them to finish their schooling with the European Baccalaureate (EB) ensure high standards of knowledge and enrollment to any university in the European Union.



Education and schooling in the European School Ljubljana lasts for 12 years, 5 years at the primary school level and 7 years at the secondary school level.

THE EUROPEAN SCHOOL LJUBLJANA OFFERS INSTRUCTION IN TWO LANGUAGE SECTIONS, SLOVENIAN AND ENGLISH SECTION.

A pupil attends the language section in his/her native/dominant language.

If none of the language sections correspond to the pupil's native language, the pupil is usually integrated and enrolled in the English language section, under special conditions also in the Slovenian language section.

Pupils in the European School Ljubljana are offered language learning of the EU working languages, i.e. English, French and German, as their first foreign language. Individual subjects are partially or fully taught in the first foreign language.

At the secondary school level pupils in the European School Ljubljana are offered English, French, German, Italian and Spanish as their second foreign language learning.

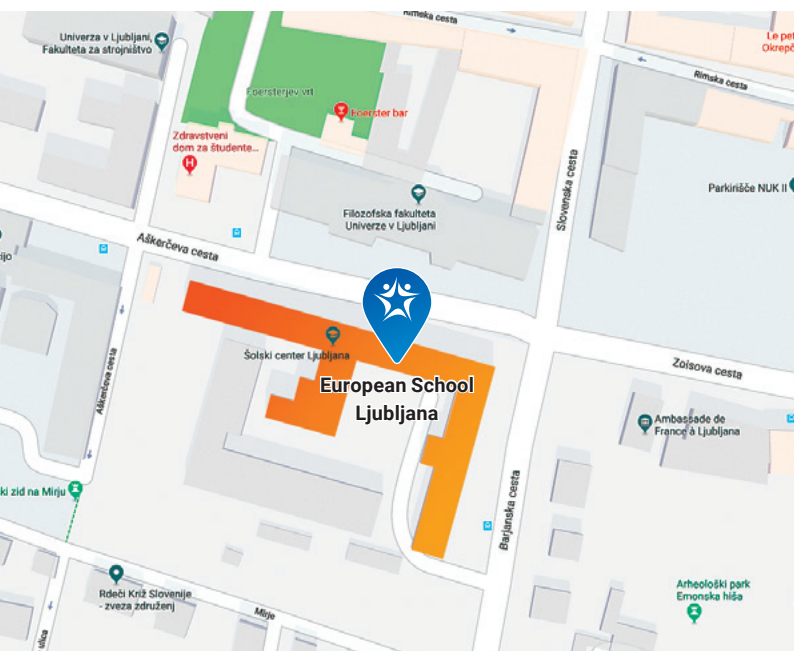

- In the first and second years of the primary school the lesson lasts 30 mins.
- As a second language – first foreign language the pupil can choose between English, German and French.
- * Slovenian is a compulsory subject taught as an additional language 2 periods per week in English section only.

The European School Ljubljana is located in the centre of Ljubljana, in a building of the Ljubljana School Center, Aškerčeva Street 1, opposite the French Embassy.

The very entrance of the school can be reached by car following the Barjanska Street driveway, where parking spaces are available. You can also access us by using public transport.

The following bus lines bring you to our premises:

- lines 1, 1B, 6 and 6B, bus stop on Aškerčeva Street
- line 9, bus stop on Barjanska Street
- lines 2, 3, 3B, 3G, 11, 11B, 19B, 19I, 27 in 78, bus stop on Zoisova Street
